- Race 7 & 8 will be allowed this year but non-compliance following that will be scored in accordance with sailing instructions.
- Feb 2018 deadline for CAT 7 compliance and must be checked by a club auditor before race one.
- NHTYA banner unanimously voted to be remade with slight variation
- 9th December for Christmas party:
- BBQ, too late to order spit, meat to be ordered from Rathmines butcher and prawns from Fisho by Chris Keevers, club will cover cost for meat
- Bring salad and dessert and register this on spreadsheet on website (password required)
- Gas bottles to be swapped at swap and go by Kevin
- BBQ cooks will be organised on the night
- Secret Santa \$10 limit per person
- Lights to be arranged by Brian
- Receiving duty points: If an owner wants to participate in an away event (race) which is on the same day as a club race, they are to inform Race Organiser prior to that day to claim point. Limit to one event per year and must be a trailerable yacht event.
- Handicap for Spinnakers versus non-spinnakers: Top Yacht makes allowances for up to 5% either up or down, in every race, for every entrant when calculating Personal Handicaps (PBH).
- This is the way the club will continue scoring races by allowing Top Yacht to compensate for different sail configurations.
- However. CBH for a non-spinnaker flier is calculated once and that CBH is applied without change in all subsequent races. CBH's to now in NHTYA have only been applied in Regatta i.e. The 3 and 6 hour races.

John

- Time of race start: 11.30 briefing, 12.00 start

Phil

- Problem where dates used for all major happenings in club don't work with racing. Fees have to be paid before fees are set. Money FY starts in April
- Phil presented a time line of dates when fees etc. were due.
- Suggestion to move clubs Membership FY back to June/July, causing AGM to need to occur in February. Currently point score finishes end of May (Autumn series). Presentation night would need to move to March. Constitution would require a process of 3 or 4 months to make any changes.

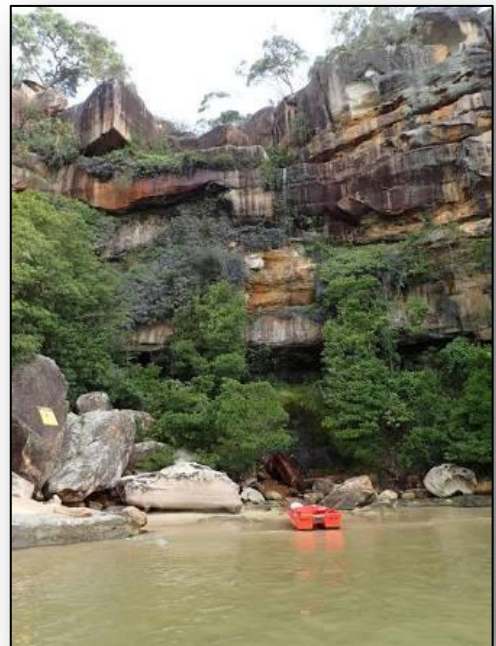
If conditions are good we will sail from Parsley Bay to Patonga and back onto beach for lunch. Back anchors will be required.

NOTICE OF RACE

Autumn Series 2018

1. RULES

- 1.1 The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing Category 7 and any Australian Sailing amendments, each yacht's Class Rules (except where any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), the Australian Trailable Sport Boat rule (ATYSBR) and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 This series will be run as a mixed class series. Spinnakers can be flown.
- 1.3 Each race is required to have a minimum of 4 boats signed on to start the race. If less than 4, the race will not be part of the race series.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A as noted in Clause 80 (page 49).

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The races are open to all NHTYA members and visitors.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows: Spring Series \$40.00, or \$10 per race till \$40.00 has been accrued. Fees are to be paid prior to participating in any race or the yacht will be scored DSQ.

5. RACE SERIES

- 5.1 The race series will consist of 8 races.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration:-The Day of the Race Prior to Briefing Time.
- 6.2 Dates of racing 2018:

10 th February	Race 1	11 th February	Race 2
10 th March	Race 3	11 th March	Race 4
7 th April	Race 5	8 th April	Race 6
5 th May	Race 7	6 th May	Race 8

- 6.3 Number of races:

Division Numbers	Races per day
1 to 4	One race on Saturdays and one race on Sundays. Except re-run races conducted as a second race on the next Saturday race day

6.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race briefing is Saturday 11.30am and Sunday 10.30am.

7. **EQUIPMENT and MEASUREMENT CHECKS**

7.1 A boat or its equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the Sailing Instructions. On the water a boat can be instructed by a Race Committee Officer to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

8.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the NHTYA web site www.trailersailer.org .

9. **VENUE**

9.1 The races will be conducted on Lake Macquarie in New South Wales.

9.2 The venue will be Styles Point for races 1 to 4, then “F” Jetty for races 5 to 8 if it not under repair.

9.3 Directions for visitors:- Styles Point is at Rathmines and is accessed by Dorrington Road then Overhill Road. “F” Jetty, is also at Rathmines and is accessed by Dorrington Road then 300 metres past Overhill Road take a left turn just before the “Catalina Conference Centre”.

10. **THE COURSES**

10.1 The courses to be sailed will be selected from the club Courses or as determined at the race briefing. (see the Sailing Instructions Addendum B). The race organiser will use the B.O.M/Meteye site for weather assessments.

11. **PENALTY SYSTEM**

11.1 Rule 44.1 (page 29) is changed so that the “Two Turn Penalty” is replaced by the “One Turn Penalty”.

12. **SCORING**

12.1 The primary scoring system will be based on personal handicap (BPH) results utilising the “Top Yacht Club Score” software.

12.2 The secondary scoring system will be based on Class Basic Handicap (CBH) results utilising the “Top Yacht” software, and is to be calculated by utilising each boat’s elapsed time for each race conducted within the 2017 Spring Series and the 2018 Autumn Series and multiplied by the CBH for that class of boat. 80% of the best results for that boat to count towards the series.

12.3 Low point scoring system described in A4.1 (page 56) will apply.

12.4 Any NHTYA Club Member absent from an NHTYA race because they are participating in another club’s race, will be scored as a “DUTY” boat and receive an average of her 4 best scores provided they advise the handicapper before the running of the NHTYA race for which their absence is to be scored. Limited to one non-club race event.

12.5 Any Series Ties to be resolved using clause A8 (page 58)

13. **THE START & SUPPORT BOATS**

13.1 The start will be between an Association buoy and a flag on the start boat, unless otherwise notified at the briefing. Committee Boats will be used as support boats as required.

14. **RADIO COMMUNICATION**

14.1 All boats shall monitor “VHF Channel 72” while racing. A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.

15. **PRIZES**

15.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

Medal for 1st 2nd & 3rd in each race.

Husband and wife/partner trophy for the first husband and wife/partner across the line.

15.2 Trophies as follows:

- Winner of the Autumn Series based on PBH
- Winner of the combined Spring & Autumn Series based on PBH
- Winner of the combined Spring and Autumn Series based on CBH

15.3 The crew of a prize winning boat (not being a spouse/partner of the owner):-

- Having paid club membership, and
- Having paid race fees, and
- Participated in a minimum of 80% of the races on that boat in that series,

Shall be eligible for an individual award.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.4 Competitors participate in the Autumn Series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 Decision to Race (page 12). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after any of the Series races.

15.5 INSURANCE

15.6 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000.00 per event or the equivalent.

16. PERSON IN CHARGE

17. All yacht skippers must have current

1. Yachting Australia membership
2. Race fees paid
3. Members must have current NHTYA club membership.
4. Failing any of these, the yacht will be scored as DSQ (Disqualified).

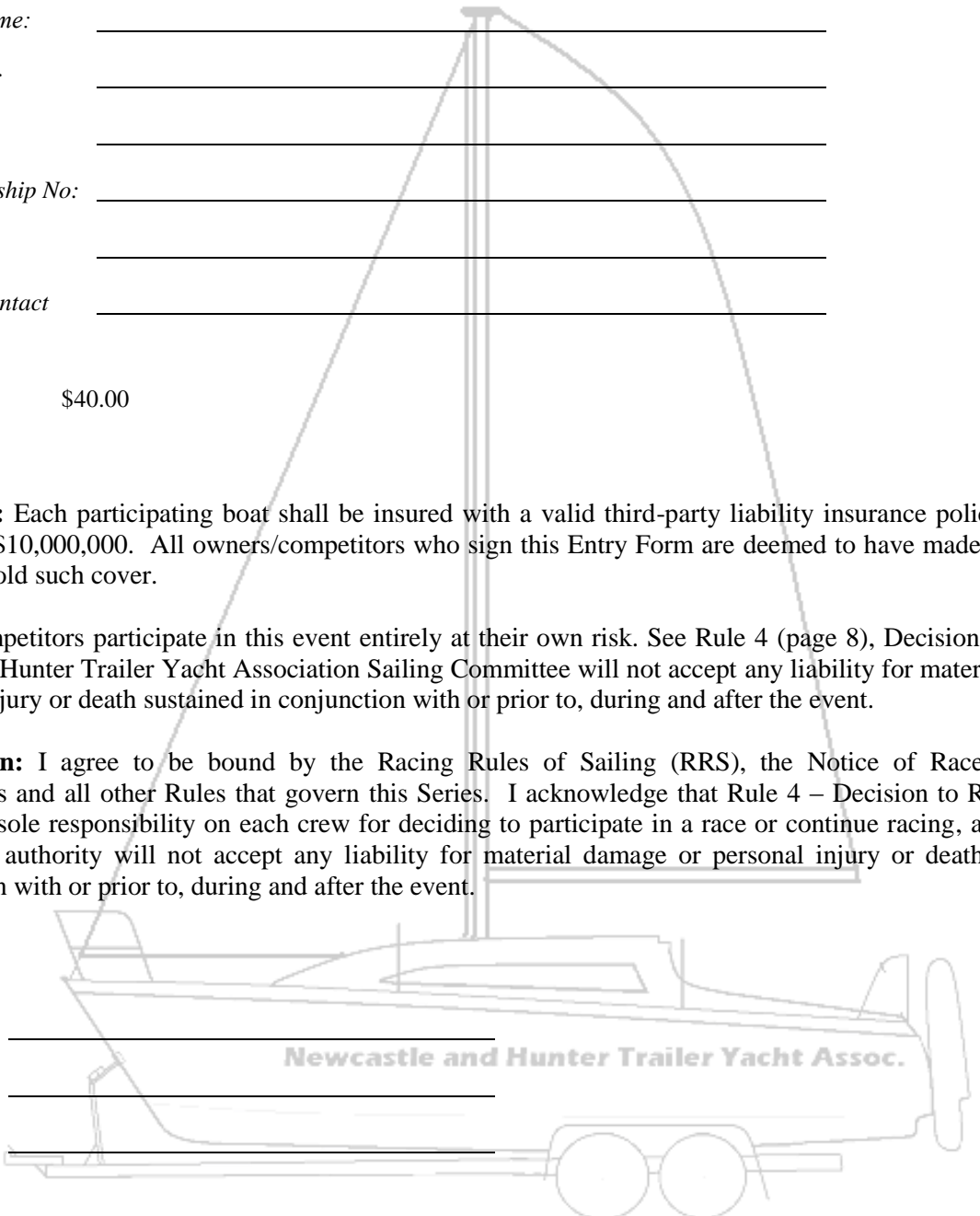

There is a section of the river >150kms with no ability to resource food or fuel so some planning is involved- More info will come.

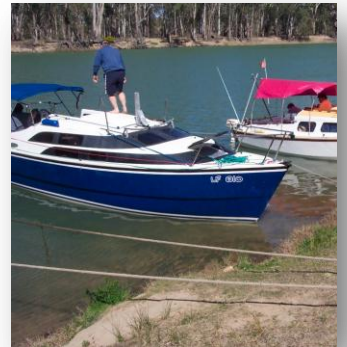
You will need to make sure your motor is comfortable to manage a constant min speed of 5knots..

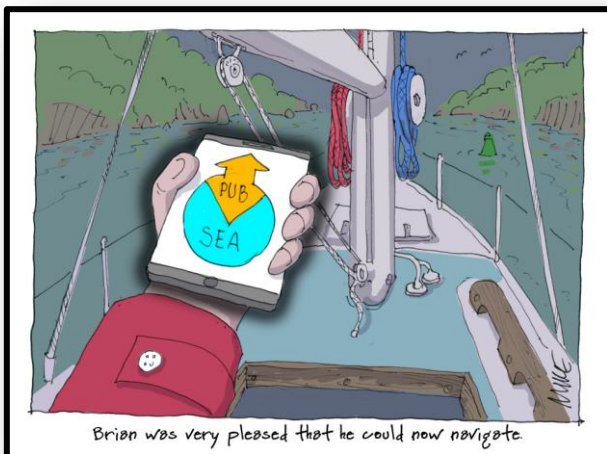
