REFLECTIONS OF A RACE WEEKEND, 13 & 14 APRIL 2024

When you see real estate agent photos of the interiors of luxury water front houses, you often see hanging on the wall images of yachts sailing on the water. I see it as a great privilege to be actually out there sailing on the water, doing what even those who own multi millionaire dollar houses wish they could be doing!

The race weekend of 13 & 14 April was one of those events that fitted the utopian image of classic fair weather sailing. The weather forecast of showers and light winds was only half right with no precipitation at all.

We race from F Jetty in the cooler months so we don't have to wade through the colder water.

Saturday morning had nine boats rig up on the concrete hardstand. We welcomed an old boat with new owners *Full of Rascals* now sailed by David and his wife Linda, although Rob Rimmington from *Scallywag* crewed on Saturday. After the race briefing it was out into the light airs with Hart Peters managing the two starts for us. The course was set for a rounding of Fishing Point and then Swansea Marks before heading back to Rathmines. *Full of Rascals* showed off the Castle 650's light air capability by being first around Swansea Mark and first over the finish line followed by *TicTac* honing up their spinnaker skills in preparation for the Bay to Bay race in May. Third over the line was *True North* with a third crew member Rob, another Castle 650 owner from Bathurst. *Black Magic* with Peter, Karen and Robin on board showed their continuing improvement and they were very excited by being first on handicap for the first time.

It was a real party at the Catalina Bowling Club on Saturday night with us booking out two large tables. Great to see extra members, families and friends attend meal.

Sunday dawned sunny and still. Bacon and egg rolls and lots of visitors on a crowded F Jetty asking about our boats. The breeze was light but we set a longer course than yesterday with the hope the breeze would improve. So it was around Coal Pt to LMYC, Marks Pt, Coal Pt mark and home to Rathmines.

Free Spirit started the fleet on long upwind trek to the LMYC mark in the light breeze. The first leg taking the lead boats about an hour to complete. *Full of Racals* held a slight lead over *True North* for much of the race finishing 1 minute and 20 seconds ahead. *Tic Tac* was next and *Jocomo*, ably assisted by new crew member Dave, took bragging rights for the Noelexes. Handicap honours went to *Full of Rascals*, *Black Magic* and *Jocomo*.

It was a great weekend's sailing with a number of new crew joining our boats.
