General Business:-

Charmain

- Expressed concern there is minimal return on merchandise and extra stock being held for a long time
- Discussion followed that historically merchandise has been used as a promotional idea to advertise the club and is a valuable resource to maintain. Also given to new members (eg caps and burpees)
- Suggestion made to supply long sleeve shirts and broad brim hats to meet sun safe requirements
- Possibly reduce price to clear some stock if necessary
- Complete an inventory of what is available and promote the extra stock in magazine to deal with over supply

John P

- Confirmed Zoom will be used for next general meeting (date 16/6/20) until further notice
- All agreed using Zoom has been overall a positive experience especially as it has allowed distant members to attend meetings online- will continue to utilise this technology to enable all members to access general meetings, particularly those living away from local area
- Password to access Zoom meetings will be removed from the magazine and Kevin's contact details will be supplied to allow visitors to join meetings as required
- Aquatics Committee Meetings- a second person will assist John P when he is unable to attend meetings due to shift work

Chris K

- A decision will be made for a date to re-commence race season ensuring we comply with COVID requirements/regulations.
- This will be made closer to the date due to restrictions changing constantly

John A

- Suggested a December weekend to be included in the race season to allow for flexibility due to COVID changes and unpredictable weather conditions at that time of year
- However this could be difficult due to limited available weekends in December (Christmas, other commitments etc)
- Possibly 5-6th Dec as a reserve weekend for catch-up races

Brian

- Suggested that OTB racing be formally recognised as a division in the club, with relevant insurance required (minimum 3rd party) and be included as members of the club
- Include race fees, one season, trophies and rules to be subservient to the trailer sailers
- OTB races not to clash with race weekends

Phil

- Discussed OTB racing to be formally recognised as a division needs to be entered into the constitution
- Proposed changes to constitution need to be discussed and passed by members at a general meeting (proposed for July meeting)
- Members will be emailed 21 days prior to this special general meeting regarding above proposed changes so consideration can be given to proposal

Garry

- Agreed OTB racing will require club membership
- A positive venture for the club and great for families
- Reminder that social distancing needs to continue to be maintained during club meetings

Charmain

- OTB racing development- queried whether accounting needs to be kept separate or included in current club accounts
- Decision- only the race fees will be different but will be included in club account

Graeme

- Queried- are medallions still needed for races or are they redundant?- extra costs for the club?
- Decision- will continue to use them as the cost is covered by race fees and it is a tradition in the club
- **Cruising-** August cruise will go ahead with COVID restrictions being lifted (at this point in time)
- Wangi Caravan Park- on shore cruise? (determined by weather) run by Brian & Val
- Flyer to come!
- Stressed- as a club we need to continue to monitor COVID requirements during sailing/cruising season and ensure we have procedures and protocols in place for our safety

ELECTRONIC LABELLER – A SAILOR’S FRIEND

My family often gives me a hard time over my affection with my Brother P-touch 1000 electronic labeller. Years ago, a naive and foolish attempt to label our refrigerator shelves led to my wife labeling the bottom drawer as “Decayed Vegetables”. I was patting our dog one day when I noticed that my son-in-law had put a label on the dog’s collar saying “Dog”.

But when it comes to the boat and my workshop, these are my provinces and labeling can flourish without baseless persecution.



But there are two very important labels I have put on the boat.

Mast Height

I have put a label indicating the boat’s mast height above the waterline, on the cockpit side of the coach house bulkhead. I figure that drifting down on the tide towards an overhead bridge or power line is not the time to be thinking “Is my mast height 9 or 9.5m, oh no, maybe it’s 10m!”. Measure you mast and then add the distance from the mast step to the boat’s waterline.



Owner's Mobile Number

The second label I have put just above my boarding ladder and it displays my mobile phone number. If I'm not around the boat and there is an issue with the boat at a jetty, beach or even in a car park, I'd like to be contacted quickly.



There are heaps of labels inside the boat on safety gear, fire extinguisher inspection date, electronic switchboard etc. They are waterproof and look professional.

Anyway, from my observations, most sailors are a little bit obsessive!

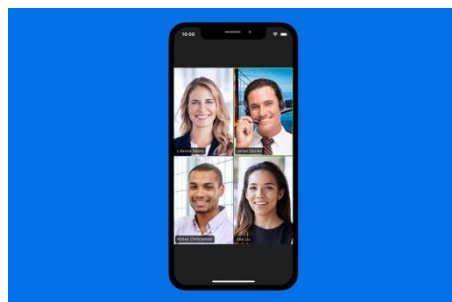


